

BY-LAW NO. 564

Whereas it is considered necessary to fix the salary of the Secretary Treasurer and define the duties of the said official and to fix the amount of Fees to be paid to the said official for any extra work that may be required to be done by him.

The Council of the Rural Municipality enacts as follows -

That the Secretary Treasurer will be paid for the current year 1936 the sum of \$~~1,700~~^{1,700}...Dollars and he shall perform all the duties required of him by the Municipal Institutions Act of Manitoba.

He shall be entitled to receive and keep all fees for searches, etc. in connection with his office. The Secretary Treasurer, if required, shall put up all notices, superintend the letting of and completion of all contracts for which he shall be paid 10 cents per mile necessarily travelled each way.

Should it be necessary to send the Secretary Treasurer to Winnipeg on business in connection with the Municipality he shall be paid for his services, his expenses in connection with the same. This same order applies to any other point outside the Municipality where the Secretary may be sent on business in connection with the Municipality.

The foregoing By-Law was introduced and passed the seventh day of January A.D. 1936.
