

By-Law No. 571 of the Rural Municipality of Morris pursuant to the provisions of "The Land Drainage Arrangement Act, 1935" assuming liability for drainage levies against land within the Municipality, issuing debentures to secure payment thereof and levying annual rates to pay such debentures and to make an annual contribution to a maintenance fund for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of the drains, bridges and culverts constructed under "The Land Drainage Act" of "The Land Drainage Arrangement Act, 1935".

WHEREAS the persons appointed under the provisions of "The Land Drainage Arrangement Act, 1935" have reported to the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council recommending that the amount of the liability for Drainage debenture debt which the Rural Municipality of Morris should assume is the sum of \$323,854.24 as at the 1st day of May, 1936 and that such liability together with interest thereon from the date aforesaid at the rate of 4½ percent per annum should be repaid to the province of Manitoba in equal annual consecutive instalments of \$21,840.42 each commencing on the 1st. day of May, 1937 and ending on the 1st day of May 1961 and that such payments should be secured by annuity debentures in the form prescribed by the Municipal and Public Utility Board.

AND WHEREAS the said persons have also reported to the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council recommending that the Rural Municipality of Morris assist in providing a fund for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of drains, bridges and culverts now or hereafter constructed under "The Land Drainage Act" or "The Land Drainage Arrangement Act, 1935" within the area set up by Order in Council No. and known as Drainage Maintenance District No. E. G. & V. and that a board of maintenance trustees be appointed to administer the maintenance fund for the said Drainage Maintenance District, and that the contribution to be made to the said maintenance fund by the Rural Municipality of Morris be the annual contribution determined from time to time by the Board of Maintenance Trustees for Drainage Maintenance District No. E.G.& V., but not less than one percentum of the total capital expenditure as represented by the total amount of debentures issued from the commencement for drainage works and the province of Manitoba has agreed that the contribution to be made thereto by the province shall be one-half or one-third as the case may be, the amount agreed to be contributed annually by the Municipalities for maintenance to said Board of Maintenance Trustees provided however that the contribution of the province in any one year to all the Drainage Maintenance Districts in the province shall not in the aggregate exceed thirty thousand dollars.

AND WHEREAS the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council by Order in Council No. 602/35 approved the 30th day of April 1935 has made effective, valid and binding certain recommendations of the said persons appointed under the provisions of the said Act as varied and amended by said Order-in-Council in so far as the Rural Municipality of Morris is concerned.

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris in so far as it is concerned has approved of the recommendations of the said persons as varied or amended by and set out in Order-in-Council No. 602/35 and has agreed to assume such liability to repay same, to issue debentures of the Municipality securing repayment thereof and to annually contribute to a maintenance fund as herein provided.

AND WHEREAS section 8 of the said "The Land Drainage Arrangement Act, 1935" provides inter alia as follows:

"An order or orders of the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council adjusting apportioning, discharging, releasing or extending the time for payment of either principal or interest, or both, or settling the amount of any indebtedness to the province of land subject to Drainage levies shall be sufficient authority.

(b) For the Council of the Municipality to pass the necessary by-laws, issue and deliver the necessary debentures and impose and levy the necessary rates for the payment of such debentures, or to provide its annual contribution to the Maintenance fund."

AND WHEREAS section 10 of the said Act provides inter alia as follows:

"10. (1) To enable a Municipality to assume the liability for drainage levies against land within the municipality, the Council of a municipality, in accordance with the provisions of the order-in-Council authorizing same, is hereby authorized and empowered, from time to time, to pass by-laws, levying rates on the land described in the said by-law or by-laws, to issue annuity or serial debentures in such form as the Municipal and Public Utility Board may prescribe and execute and deliver such debentures to the Provincial Treasurer.

(2) To enable a municipality to make its annual contribution to the maintenance fund, the Council of the municipality is hereby authorized and empowered, from time to time, to pass by-laws for levying rates on the land described in the said by-law or by-laws sufficient to provide the amount necessary to pay its annual contribution to the said maintenance fund, and to pay the proceeds of such rate or rates to the trustee of the maintenance fund.

(5) It shall not be necessary for a municipality to submit any by-law passed under the provisions of this section to the electors or ratepayers of the municipality, but no by-law of a municipality for the issue of debentures under the provisions of this section shall have any force or effect until it has been approved by the Municipal and Public Utility Board; and the said Board for the purposes aforesaid shall have all the powers given to it by "The Municipal and Public Utility Board Act" for approving of By-laws providing for the issue of debentures by a municipality."

AND WHEREAS for the purpose of assuming and securing repayment of such liability it is necessary for the Rural Municipality of Morris to issue an annuity debenture for the total sum of \$21,840.42 repayable within a term of 25 years and bearing interest from the 1st day of May, 1936 at the rate of $4\frac{1}{2}$ percent per annum payable annually.

AND WHEREAS the total amount to be raised annually for paying the said liability and interest is the sum of \$21,840.42 for the said period of 25 years.

AND WHEREAS for the purpose of providing a fund for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of drains, bridges and culverts now or hereafter constructed under "THE Land Drainage Act" or "The Land Drainage Arrangement Act, 1935" it is necessary for the Rural Municipality of Morris to raise annually for such purpose until otherwise provided by the Board of Maintenance Trustees for Drainage Maintenance District No. E. G. & V. the sum of \$3,238.33 being one percentum of the total capital expenditures as represented by the total amount of debentures issued from the commencement for Drainage works in the Rural Municipality of Morris.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to annually levy on the lands described in schedule "A" to this by-law a special rate or rates over and above all other rates sufficient to produce the amount necessary to pay the portion of the drainage debenture debt assumed by the Rural Municipality of Morris and falling due and payable in each year and to pay same over to the Provincial Treasurer.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary until otherwise provided to annually levy on the lands described in schedule "A" to this by-law a special rate or rates over and above all other rates sufficient to produce the amount necessary to pay the annual contribution of the Rural Municipality of Morris to the said maintenance fund and as and when required to pay same over to the Board of Maintenance Trustees for Drainage Maintenance District No. E. G. & V.

AND WHEREAS the value of the rateable property set out in schedule "A" to this by-law according to the last revised assessment roll of the Rural Municipality of Morris is \$1,819,992.00.

AND WHEREAS the debt hereby created is created on the security of a special rate upon the land described in said schedule "A" to this by-law and on that security only.

AND WHEREAS the amount of the existing debenture debt of the Rural Municipality of Morris is \$36,962.66 of which no sum for principal or interest is in arrears.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris in Council assembled enacts as follows:

(1) The Rural Municipality of Morris hereby approves of the recommendations of the persons appointed under the provisions of "The Land Drainage Arrangement Act, 1935" as varied or amended by Order-in-Council No. 620/35 in so far as the Rural Municipality of Morris is concerned and hereby agrees to ~~max~~ carry into effect the provisions of Order-in-Council No. 620/35 and hereby assumes liability for and agrees to pay to the Province of Manitoba the sum of \$323,854.29 together with interest from the 1st day of May, 1936 at the rate of $4\frac{1}{2}$ per cent per annum being the amount of the liability for drainage debenture debt which the said persons recommended that the Rural Municipality of Morris should assume and which recommendation the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council has made effective, valid and binding on the Municipality and the Province.

(2) For the purpose of assuming the said liability for drainage debenture debt there shall be and is hereby borrowed on the credit of the said Rural Municipality of Morris the sum of \$323,854.29 and a debt for the said sum is hereby created and to secure repayment thereof an annuity debenture shall be and is hereby issued therefor payable over a period of 25 years and bearing interest at the rate of $4\frac{1}{2}$ per cent per annum payable annually. The principal of the said debt and interest thereon shall be repayable by yearly sums of \$21,840.42 on the 1st day of May in each of the years during a period of 25 years the first payment to be made on the 1st day of May 1937, the annual payments to be such that the aggregate amount payable for principal and interest in any year shall be equal as nearly as possible to what is payable for principal and interest

during each of the other years of such period.

(3) The Reeve and Treasurer of the Rural Municipality of Morris are hereby authorized to issue said debenture to which shall be attached coupons for the respective annual sums payable and to deliver the said debenture and coupons to the Provincial Treasurer of the Province of Manitoba.

(4) The debenture coupons shall be payable at the office of the Provincial Treasurer in the province of Manitoba and shall be payable in lawful money of Canada.

(5) The Reeve of the said municipality shall sign the said debenture and the same shall be signed by the Secretary-Treasurer of the said municipality and sealed with the seal of the said municipality. The coupons attached may be signed by the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer or may be executed by each one having printed or lithographed thereon the facsimile signature of the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer of the municipality. Each coupon shall be numbered with the number of the debenture to which it is attached.

(6) In each and every year commencing with the year 1936 and during the said period of 25 years the sum of \$21,840.42 shall annually be raised, levied and imposed by a special rate sufficient therefor over and above all other rates upon and against all of the rateable and taxable property set out in schedule "A" to this by-law for the payment of the said debt and interest.

(7) The Rural Municipality of Morris hereby agrees to become part of Drainage Maintenance District No. E. G. & V. set up by said Order-in-Council No. 620/35 and to comply with and carry out all the requirements of the Board of Maintenance Trustees of said Drainage Maintenance District No. and until otherwise provided hereby appoints C. L. Stoney of the Post Office of Morris as the representative of the Rural Municipality of Morris on the Board of Maintenance Trustees of Drainage Maintenance District No. 2, 6 and 12.

(8) In each and every year commencing with the year 1936 and until otherwise required by the Board of Maintenance Trustees of Drainage Maintenance District No. the sum of \$8,786.84 shall annually be raised, levied and imposed by a special rate sufficient therefor over and above all other rates upon and against all of the rateable and taxable property described in ~~the~~ schedule "A" to this by-law for the payment of the annual sum of \$8,786.84 being the annual contribution of the Rural Municipality of Morris to a maintenance fund for the maintenance, repair and upkeep of drains, bridges and culverts now or hereafter constructed under the provisions of "The Land Drainage Act" of "The Land Drainage Arrangement Act, 1935".

(9) If the proceeds of the special rate or rates levied in any year be insufficient to pay the Municipality's contribution to the maintenance fund and the portion of the Drainage debenture debt assumed by the municipality shall by by-law impose and levy in the following year against all the land described in the schedule to this by-law a special rate over and above all other rates sufficient to produce the amount necessary to make up any deficiency in the amount realized from the special rate or rates imposed in the previous year.

(10) The proceeds of all or any special rate or rates levied under this by-law or any other by-law for the payment of the said debt and interest shall belong to and be the property of His Majesty the King in the Right of the province and shall be deposited by the Treasurer of the Municipality in a special trust account in a chartered bank to be called "Drainage Debenture Trust Account" and shall be recorded in a special trust account in the books of the municipality.

(11) The proceeds of all or any special rate or rates levied under this by-law or any other by-law for the annual contribution to a maintenance fund shall belong to and be the property of the Board of Maintenance Trustees for Drainage Maintenance District No. 2, 6 and 12, and shall be deposited by the Treasurer of the municipality in a special trust account in a chartered bank to be called "Drainage Maintenance Trust Account" and shall be recorded in a special trust account in the books of the municipality.

(12) The said debenture shall contain a provision in the following words or to the like effect:

Neither this debenture nor any interest therein shall after a certificate of ownership has been endorsed thereon by the Treasurer of the municipality be transferable except by an entry by the Treasurer or his deputy in the debenture registry book of the said Rural Municipality of Morris at Morris in the province of Manitoba.

(13) This by-law shall not have any force or effect until it has been approved by the Municipal and Public Utility Board. Upon the said approval being obtained, this by-law shall be deemed to have been in force and had effect from the 1st day of May, 1936.

(14) It is hereby expressly declared and agreed that this by-law is passed and the debenture and coupons herein provided are issued under pursuant and subject to all the provisions of "The Land Drainage Arrangement Act, 1935" applicable thereto, which provisions are hereby incorporated in and deemed to form part of this by-law.

(15) This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of May, 1936.
