

By-LAW NO. 583.

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality for the purpose of fixing a place of meeting of the Council and fixing the Remuneration to be paid to the Reeve and Councillors and the day of holding regular meetings of Council for the year 1937.

The Reeve and Councillors of the said Municipality shall be paid for their services as follows, that is to say -

For attending each meeting of the Council \$4.00 and 10 cents per mile for each mile travelled to and from such place of meeting provided that the indemnity shall not exceed for all purposes, except mileage the sum of \$100.00 in one year as provided by Chapter 57 of the Municipal Act revised.

Should it be necessary at any regular meeting of the Council to change the date of the next regular meeting, the Council may if carried by a majority of the Council present, change the date of the next regular meeting to an earlier or later date than the third friday.

Special meetings of the Council may be convened at any time by the Reeve and two members of the Council by giving, before the day of meeting a reasonable notice of such meeting to all members of the Council, such notice may be verbal or in writing sent by registered mail to the address of the members of the Council, or notice may be delivered by some person employed to deliver such notice.

Each notice of a special meeting shall contain notice of the subjects which are to be taken up at the special meeting.

The Council shall meet at one o'clock of the day of each regular meeting and if there is no Quorum at the expiration of two hours after the time appointed for the meeting, the Council shall stand adjourned to the next regular meeting thereof, and the Clerk shall enter in the minutes the names of the members present.

The Reeve of the Municipality shall preside at all meetings of the Council or in his absence the members of the Council present may fifteen minutes after the appointed hour, appoint a chairman from the members present, and such chairman shall have the same authority and exercise the same functions in presiding as the Reeve could have.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris shall hold their regular meetings in the County Court House, Morris, on the third friday in each month.

Should the Reeve or any Councillor be appointed by resolution to go to Winnipeg or any other place on business of the Municipality they shall be paid the sum of \$5.00 per day and actual travelling expenses.

The Reeve and any of the Councillors shall be paid \$4.00 per day and 10 cents per mile necessarily travelled for inspection or in performing work of other service in respect to roads, bridges, or other public works in or for the Municipality, providing that all amounts for such work be verified by a statutory declaration which has been filed with the Clerk of the Municipality and a resolution of the Council passed authorizing the payment of same, as well as previous authority from the Council to do the work.

The foregoing By-Law was passed in Council this fifth day of January A.D. 1937.
