

BY - LAW NO. 590

A by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris classifying highways under its jurisdiction, as provided by "The Highway Traffic Act."

WHEREAS it is expedient to classify the Municipal Highways under section 23 of "The Highway Traffic Act," as re-enacted by chapter 14 of the statutes of 1936,

THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris enacts as follows:

1. All highways within the boundaries of the Rural Municipality of Morris and under its jurisdiction, are hereby classified as Class "B" highways within the meaning of section 23 of "The Highway Traffic Act."
2. This by-law does not apply to :
 - (a) Provincial Trunk Highways,
 - (b) Any highway in the Municipality hereafter designated by the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council as Class "A" or Class "C" highway.
3. This by-law shall become effective upon being approved by the Municipal and Public Utility Board, as provided by "The Highway Traffic Act,"
