A By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris
for the purpose of authorizing the purchase of
the herein described land from the Rural
Municipality of Sprague (disorganized)

WHEREAS by Section 393 (b) of the Municipal Act, R.S.M.1940, a
municipal corporation may pass by-laws for the purpose of acquiring and
holding the lands situate outside the limits of the corporation, for the
use of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to purchase the hereinafter
described land for the use of the Rural Municipality of Morris;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED and it is hereby enacted as and for
by-law No. 640 of the Rural Municipality of Morris, as follows:

1. That this corporation do purchase from the Rural Municipality of
Sprague (disorganized) the North West quarter of Section Thirty-four
(34) in the First (1) Township and Thirteenth (13) Range, East of the
Principal Meridian in Manitoba, subject to the special reservations
contained in the Grant from the Crown, at and for the price and con-
sideration of Two Hundred and thirty-five (\$235.00) dollars, and the
Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer of this Municipality are hereby authorized
to complete the negotiations for said purchase, sign and seal the necessary
documents and papers, and pay out the consideration and the necessary legal
fees and disbursements to place title in the name of this Municipality, and
their actions in so doing are hereby assented to, ratified and confirmed.

DONE, ENACTED AND PASSED in meeting duly assembled at the Town of Morris, in
Manitoba, the 27th, day of July, A.D. 1940.
