

BY-LAW NO. 643 .

A By-law for the purpose of opening a public road over, across and upon the E $\frac{1}{2}$ .29-5-1 E $\frac{1}{2}$ M.

WHEREAS: It is deemed expedient to open and establish a public road over, across and upon the East half of Section Twenty-Nine (29) in the Fifth (5) Township and First (1) Range, East of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS: All the owners of the said East half of Section Twenty-nine in township Five and Range One, East of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, being all the persons affected thereby, have consented in writing to the sale of the land taken therefor and have been paid in full for the same;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED and it is hereby enacted as and for by-law Number 643 of the Rural Municipality of Morris as follows:


1. That this Municipality do open and establish a public road over, across and upon the East half of Section Twenty-nine (29) in the Fifth (5) Township and First (1) Range, East of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, as shown coloured pink on a plan of survey thereof compiled by Gilbert Beebe McColl, Manitoba Land Surveyor, and dated the 2nd day of November, A. D. 1939.

DONE, ENACTED AND PASSED in Council duly assembled at the Town of Morris, in Manitoba, the 20th day of September, A. D. 1940.
