

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MORRIS

BY-LAW NO. 649

A BY-LAW of the Rural Municipality of Morris in the Province of Manitoba, to set aside the sum of \$5,000.00 for the purchase of Victory Loan Bonds issued by the Dominion Government.

WHEREAS every Municipal Government subject to the approval of the Municipal Commissioner as per Section 629 of the Municipal Act, Chapter 141, 1940 and amendments, has the power to pass by-laws to set aside any surplus monies of the Corporation not presently required for the purpose of establishing a reserve fund.

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris duly assembled enacts as follows.

1. THAT the sum of \$5,000.00 shall be taken from the surplus of the Public Works accounts for the purpose of establishing a reserve fund and duly invested in Bonds issued by the Dominion Government bearing interest at three percent and expiring in 1951 being for a term of ten years.
2. THAT the Reeve and Clerk shall be duly authorized by this Council to made the purchase subject to the approval of the Municipal Commissioner.

DONE and passed in Council assembled in the Council Chamber this 13th day of June A.D. 1941.


