

By-Law NO. 654 of the Rural Municipality of Morris authorizing the assignment of the Tax Sale Certificate No. 7. covering the N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 17-5-2W.


WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris did purchase at the 1941 Tax Sale of the said Municipality, the following land namely, the North East Quarter of Section Seventeen in Township Five Range Two West of the First Principal Meridian in Manitoba. and the Tax Sale Certificate No. 7. dated the Eight day of December 1941 was issued in respect thereof.


And WHEREAS Peter F. Loewen of the Post Office of Morris in the Province of Manitoba, Farmer has applied for an assignment of the said Tax Sale Certificate and proceedings taken thereunder.

And WHEREAS the said Peter F. Loewen has paid to the said Municipality of Morris, the amount for which the said land was sold.

NOW THEREFOR, be it enacted as By-Law No. 654 of the Rural Municipality of Morris, that it assign, transfer, and set over unto the said Peter F. Loewen, all it's right, Title, and interest in and to the said Tax Sale Certificate, and the proceedings taken thereunder and that the Reeve and Secretary Treasurer be authorized to sign and seal the necessary Assignment.
