

By-Law No. 659

A by-law for the purpose of acquiring Lots fifty-two (52) to fifty-five (55) both inclusive, Plan 1365, St. James.

WHEREAS Fred Mazolleck and Melita Mazolleck, formerly of the Municipality of Morris, are the registered owners of Lots fifty-two (52) to fifty-five (55) both inclusive, as shown on a Plan of survey of part of Lot twelve (12) of the Parish of St. James, registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 1365.

AND WHEREAS for a number of years the Municipality has been obliged to give assistance to the said Fred Mazolleck and Melita Mazolleck, and is continuing to do so.

AND WHEREAS the said Fred Mazolleck and Melita Mazolleck have agreed to transfer the said property to the Municipality subject to unpaid taxes charged against the said property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED as and for by-law No. 659 of the Rural Municipality of Morris as follows:

1. THAT the Municipality accept from the said Fred Mazolleck and Melita Mazolleck a transfer of the following property, namely, Lots fifty-two (52) to fifty-five (55) both inclusive, which Lots are shown on a plan of survey of Part of Lot twelve (12) of the Parish of St. James, registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 1365 and that upon registration of the said transfer that the Municipality pay all current taxes and arrears of taxes charged against the said property.
