

BY-LAW No. 661 of the Rural Municipality of Morris

Releasing interest in portion of land taken from
North two (2) Chains of Lot four hundred and sixty-
six (466), Parish of Ste. Agathe for public road

WHEREAS the Municipality acquired thirty-three (33) feet in width along East side of highway, known as St. Mary's Road over and upon River Lots three hundred and thirty-eight (338) to four hundred and forty-six (446), both inclusive.

AND WHEREAS it was never intended to acquire said thirty-three (33) feet in width to East of said Highway on the most Northerly two (2) chains in width of River Lot four hundred and forty-six (446) and no compensation was paid for said land.

AND WHEREAS it is not deemed advisable or necessary to retain any claim or lien upon the said property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED as by-law No. of the Rural Municipality of Morris:

THAT the Municipality do hereby release any and all claims over and upon the thirty-three (33) feet in perpendicular width of the most Northerly two (2) chains in depth of River Lot four hundred and forty-six (446) of the Parish of Ste. Agathe, lying to the East of the St. Mary's Highway as shown on a Plan filed in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office.
