of 36-6-2 West.



WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is the owner of the following land, namely: The East half of Section thirty-five (35) and the West half of Section thirty-six (36) both in Township six (6) and Range two (2) West of the Principal Meridian.

AND WHEREAS Mogens Nielsen of the Village of Sperling, in the Province of Manitoba, farmer, has offered to purchase the said parcel of land for the sum of Five Thousand, one hundred and twenty Dollars (\$5,120.00) and it is deemed advisable to accept said offer.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted as by-law No. of the Rural Municipality of Morris that the offer of Mogens Nielsen of Five Thousand one hundred and twenty (\$5120.00) Dollars for the East half of Section thirty-five (35) and the west half of Section thirty-six (36) both in Township six (6) and Range two (2) West of the Principal Meridian, in the Province of Manitoba be and is hereby accepted and that the Reeve and Secretary-treasurer be authorized to execute a transfer of the said lands on the payment of the said purchase price.
