

By-law No. 671<sup>2</sup> of the Rural Municipality  
of Morris.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is the owner of the following land, namely: In the Village of Sperling, in the Province of Manitoba, and being Lots three (3) and Four (4), in Block five (5) as shewn on a plan of survey of part of the Village of Sperling, registered in the Carman Land Titles Office as No. 916.


AND WHEREAS Shirley O. Johnson, of the Village of Sperling, in the Province of Manitoba, automobile dealer, has offered to purchase the said parcel of land for the sum of One Hundred and twenty (\$120.00) Dollars and it is deemed advisable to accept said offer.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted as by-law No. of the Rural Municipality of Morris that the offer of Shirley O. Johnson of One Hundred and twenty (\$120.00) Dollars for Lots three (3) and four (4), in Block five (5) as shewn on a plan of survey of part of the Village of Sperling registered in the Carman Land Titles Office as No. 916, ~~be~~ and is hereby accepted and the Reeve and Secretary-treasurer be authorized to execute a transfer of the said land on payment of the said purchase price.
