

BY-LAW No. 672 of the Rural Municipality of Morris


WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is the owner of the following land, namely; In the Village of Sperling, in the Province of Manitoba, and being Lots five (5) and six (6), in Block ten (10) as shewn on a plan of survey of part of the Village of Sperling, registered in the Carman Land Titles Office as No. 916.


AND WHEREAS Cornelius B. McNulty, of the Village of Sperling, in the Province of Manitoba, insurance agent, has offered to purchase the said parcel of land for the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) and it is deemed advisable to accept said offer.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted as by-law No. 672 of the Rural Municipality of Morris that the offer of Cornelius B. McNulty of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for Lots five (5) and six (6), in Block ten (10) as shewn on a plan of survey of part of the Village of Sperling registered in the Carman Land Titles Office as NO. 916, be and is hereby accepted and the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be authorized to execute a transfer of the said land on payment of the said purchase price.
