

BY-LAW No. 674 of the Rural Municipality of
Morris closing road through part of River Lot 446, Parish
of Ste. Agathe.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to close that
portion of the public road over and upon the land described
as follows:

"Part of River Lot 446, of the Parish of Ste. Agathe, in
Manitoba, and being all that portion of the Public road
according to a Plan of Survey registered in the Winnipeg
Land Titles Office as No. 4116 coloured green on the Plan
of Gilbert Reeb McColl, dated December 6th 1943".

AND WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law was
duly inserted in four consecutive issues of the Morris
Herald and six notices placed in conspicuous places in the
District pursuant to the Municipal Act.


AND WHEREAS no objections have been taken to the
proposed by-law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED as by-law no.
of the Rural Municipality of Morris as follows:

1. THAT the public highway over and upon the land
above referred to be and is hereby closed.
2. THAT the portion of the highway over and upon the
said land be sold to the owners of the adjacent land, namely,
Dennis Kenny, Celestian Perrault and Cecille Perrault, each
person to pay the nominal sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar for said
land.
3. THAT the Reeve and Secretary-treasurer be and are
hereby authorized to execute the necessary documents to com-
plete the said sale.

of December, 1943.

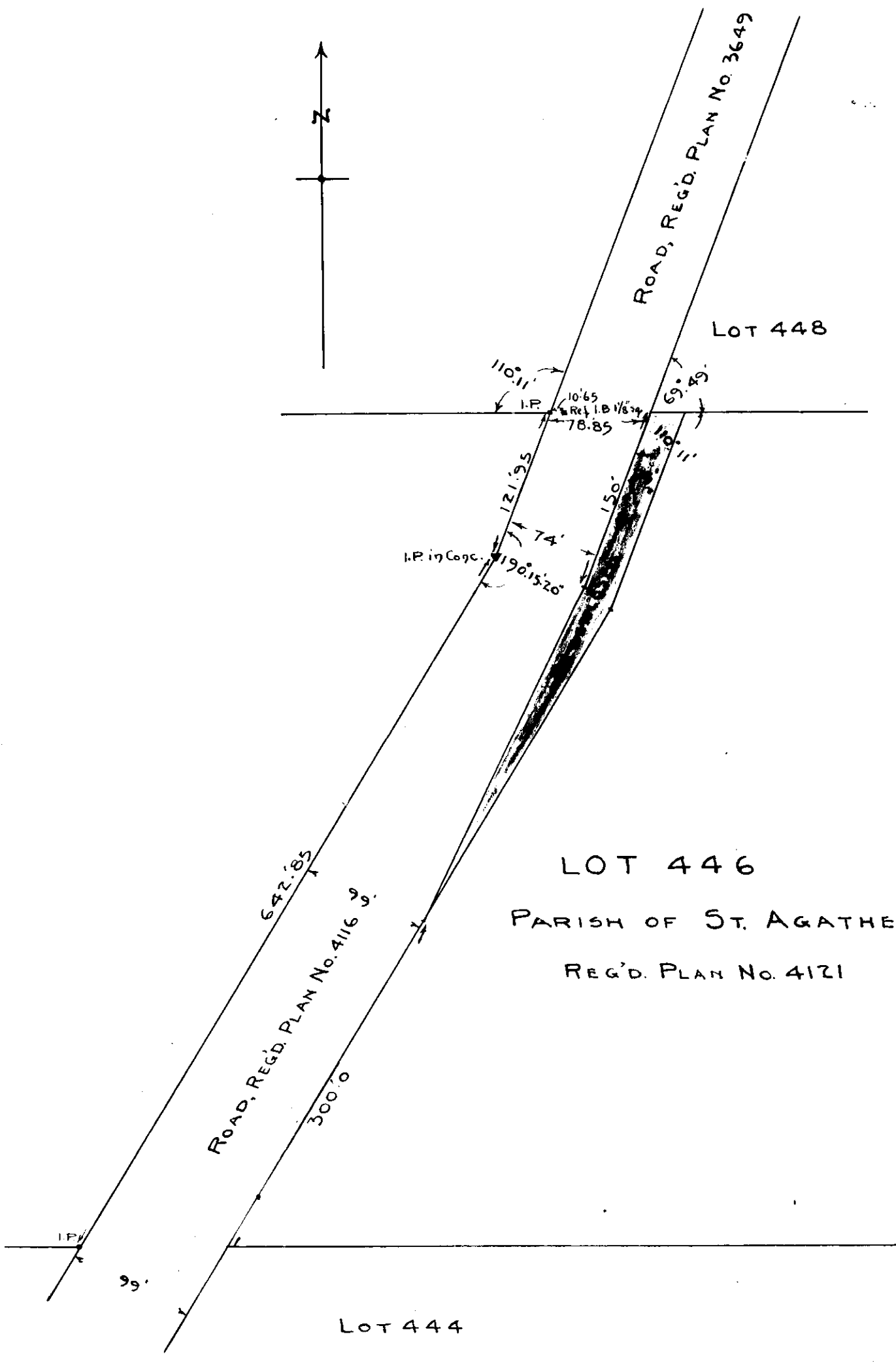
