BY-LAW No. 681 of the Rural Municipality of Morris opening road through part of South East Quarter of Section twelve (12) in Township four (4) and Range one (1) West of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, as shown on a Plan of Survey made by G. A. Warrington, M. L. S., and sworn before F. A. W. MacLean on the 2nd day of June, 1944.

WHEREAS it is desirable to open a road on the North West side of the Canadian Pacific Railway through said parcel of land as shown on said plan. AND WHEREAS the sole owner of the said land is Albert Recksiedler of the Post Office of De Wet, in the Province of Manitoba, who has consented to the opening of the said road and has agreed to the compensation to be paid therefore.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED as By-law No. 681 of the Rural Municipality of Morris that the road be opened in accordance with the said plan and that the said Albert Recksiedler be paid compensation for the portion so taken for the price of Thirty (\$30.00) and -----00/100 Dollars per acre and that the Reeve and Secretary-treasurer be authorized to execute the necessary documents in connection therewith.
