

BY-LAW No. 696 of the Rural Municipality  
of Morris opening road through  
S. E. 6-5-1 West.


WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to open a road through the Northern boundary of the town site of Lowe Farm to the Northern limit of the South East Quarter of Section six (6) in Township five (5) and Range one (1) West, along the most Westerly sixty-six (66) feet in width of said Quarter Section.


AND WHEREAS the sole owner of the said land is <sup>Jacob</sup>~~John~~ J. Reimer, of the Post Office of Lowe Farm, in the Province of Manitoba, farmer, who has consented to the opening of the said road and has agreed to the compensation to be paid therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED as by-law No. 696 of the Rural Municipality of Morris that the road be opened over and upon the most Westerly sixty-six (66) feet in width of the South East Quarter of Section six (6) in Township five (5) and Range one (1) West of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, excepting thereout the most Southerly five hundred and six (506) feet in depth thereof, and that the said <sup>Jacob</sup>~~John~~ J. Reimer be paid the sum of Seventy-five (\$75.00) Dollars in full settlement for said parcel of land and that the Reeve and Secretary-treasurer be authorized to execute the necessary documents in connection therewith.  
DONE AND PASSED at a Meeting of the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris held at Morris, Manitoba, this 21st day of December, A. D. 1945.
