

BY-LAW NO. 698

A by-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris to confirm the appointment of the Secretary-Treasurer for the year 1946.

WHEREAS at a meeting of the Council held in the County Court Hall, in the Town of Morris, on the Second day of January, A.D. 1946, the said Council did appoint *James L. Pottinger* Secretary-Treasurer for the year 1946, and whereas, it is expedient that said appointment be confirmed by by-law.

NOW THEREFOR the appointment of *James L. Pottinger* as Secretary-Treasurer of the Rural Municipality of Morris for the year 1946, be and is, hereby confirmed.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to fix the salary and define the duties of the said Secretary-Treasurer, and the amount of fees for any extra work that may be required of him, the said Council enacts as follows:

The Secretary-Treasurer shall be paid for the current year the sum of *Twenty one hundred dollars (\$2100⁰⁰)*

and shall perform all the duties required of him by "The Municipal Act of Manitoba", and if required of him, he shall put up notices, superintend the letting of contracts and completion of same, for which he shall be paid ten cents per mile necessarily travelled, or if he should be sent outside the Municipality on business, his actual expenses in connection with same shall be paid,

The foregoing by-law was introduced and passed in Council the Second day of January, A.D. 1946.
