

By-Law Number 704 (A)

By-Law No.704(A) being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris for the purpose of fixing a day and place of voting Re:Altona Hospital District Number 24 in accordance with Sec.529 B (i) of the Municipality Act which reads as follows:

(b) The corporation shall by separate By-Law,

(i) fix the day and hour when, and the place or places where the votes are to be taken, and where the votes are to be taken at more than one place shall name a Deputy Returning Officer to take the votes at every such place; and the day so fixed shall not be fewer than Three nor more than Five weeks after the first publication of the Notice respecting the taking of votes on the proposed By-Law;

Now therefore the Council Of the Rural Municipality of Morris enacts as follows:

/resident

(1) The vote of the ratepayers entitled to vote on By-Law No. 704 of the Rural Municipality of Morris shall be taken for and against said By-Law on Friday the 5th day of July A.D. 1946, at Steinfeld School-N.W.8-4-1W, between the hours of Nine o'clock in the forenoon and Six o'clock in the afternoon.

(2) On Wednesday the 3rd day of July A.D. 1946 the Reeve of the Municipality will attend at the Municipal office at Morris in the Province of Manitoba between the hours of Eleven o'clock in the forenoon and Twelve o'clock noon for the purpose, if requested, of appointing persons to attend at the final summing up of votes, and one person to attend at each of the said polling places on behalf of the persons interested in promoting or opposing By-Law No.704 respectively. The Clerk of the Municipality of Morris will attend at the Municipal Hall at Morris, Manitoba at the hour of Six o'clock in the afternoon of Friday the Fifth day of July A.D. 1946 to sum up the number of votes for and against By-Law No. 704.
