

BY-LAW No. 711

A By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris for submitting By-law No. 710 to the electors, which said By-law No. 710 relates to the creation of a debt of \$561.25 annually for the purpose of constructing, equipping and maintaining a Hospital under "The Health Services Act".

WHEREAS By-Law No. 710 of the Rural Municipality of Morris entitled, "A By-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris to authorize the annual levy of \$561.25, for the purpose of constructing, equipping and maintaining a Hospital under "The Health Services Act", has been introduced and read a first and second time by the Municipal Council of the said Rural Municipality of Morris.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris in session assembled enacts as follows:-

1. The said By-law No. 710 shall be submitted to the electors qualified to vote thereon on the 22nd day of November, A.D. 1946, and for the purpose of taking the votes thereon the Polls shall be open to the hour of five (5) o'clock in the afternoon of the said date at the following place, namely the Orange Hall, in the Village of Sperling, Manitoba.
2. The Deputy Returning Officer for taking the said votes shall be R. Meyers, of the Village of Sperling, Manitoba.
3. On the 21st day of November, A.D. 1946, at the hour of three (3) o'clock in the afternoon the Reeve of the said Rural Municipality of Morris shall attend at the Municipal Office for the purpose of appointing persons to attend at the said Polling place and also to attend at the official summing up of the votes hereinafter referred to by the Secretary-Treasurer, on behalf of the persons interested in the said By-law and of promoting or opposing the passing of the said By-law respectively.
4. On the 23rd day of November, A.D. 1946, the clerk of the Municipality will attend at the Municipal Office at the hour of ten o'clock in the forenoon, to sum up the number of votes for and against the said by-law.

DONE AND PASSED as a By-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris, on the 18th day of October, A.D. 1946.
