

By-Law No.712 of the Rural Municipality of Morris.

By-Law No.712 of the Rural Municipality of Morris,being a By-Law to provide for the nomination and election of Three Councillors for the said Rural Municipality of Morris for the years 1947 and 1948.

In pursuance of the provisions of " The Municipal Act" and ammendments thereto,the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris enacts as follows:

1. That a meeting of the Electors and rate-payers of the Municipality shall be held for receiving nominations of candidates for the offices of Councillors for Wards One,Two and Four of the said Municipality for the ensuing years A.D. 1947 and 1948,on Tuesday the 12th day of November,between the hours of One and Two O'Clock in the afternoon at the court house building in the Town of Morris,Man.,

2. That Jas.Pottinger shall be Returning Officer.

3. That if more Candidates then One be nominated for Councillor for Wards One,Two or Four at such nomination the returning officer shall announce same and shall then make known to the people present,the time and place or places when,and wherethe poll or polls shall be open for the taking of votes for the Candidates so nominated.Which shall be on Friday the 22nd day of November A.D.1946. Commencing at Nine O'Clock in the forenoon and closing at Five O'Clock in the Afternoon of the same day.

4. That the following shall be the divisions and polling places:

(a) Ward One,Poll No.One -All duly qualified Electors of the said Ward with Polling Booth at Broadview School House.

(b)Ward Two,Poll No.1-All duly qualified Electors of the said Ward living East of the C.P.R.Line with polling booth at R.Taylor's' house-N.E.24-5-1E. Poll No.2-All duly qualified electors of the said Ward living West of the C.P.R. line,at Rosenhoff School House-Sec.20-5-1E.

(c) Ward Four,Poll No.1-All duly qualified Electors of said Ward living South of the division linebetween Twps.5 & 6 ,with polling booth at Armour School house.Poll No.2-All duly qualified Electors of said Ward living North of the division line between Twps.5 & 6 with the polling booth at the Provencher School House.

The Foregoing By-Law was read a First,Second and Third time and passed this 18th day of October A.D.1946.
