

BY-LAW NO. 716.

By-Law # 716 being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris, for the purpose of fixing a place of meeting of the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris, and fixing the remuneration to be paid to the Reeve and Councillors, and the day of holding regular meetings of the Council for the year 1947.

Now therefore be it enacted, and it is hereby enacted as and for By-Law # 716 of the Rural Municipality of Morris, as follows:-

The Reeve and Councillors of the said Municipality shall be paid for their services as follows:-

For attending each meeting of the Council, \$4.00, and Ten cents per Mile for each Mile travelled to and from place of Meeting, provided that the indemnity shall not exceed for all purposes, except mileage, the sum of \$100.00 in One Year as provided by the "Municipal Act".

Should it be necessary at any regular meeting of the Council to change the date of the next regular meeting to an earlier or later date than set by this By-Law, the Council may do so if carried by a majority of the Members present.

Special meetings of the Council may be convened at any time by the Reeve and Two Members of the Council, by giving, before the day of the Meeting, a reasonable notice of such meeting to all Members of the Council. Such Notice may be verbal, or in writing sent by Registered Mail to the address of the Members of the Council, or notice may be delivered by some person employed to deliver such notice. Each Notice of a special Meeting shall contain notice of the subjects which are to be taken up at the Special Meeting.

The Council shall hold its' regular Meetings in the County Court House, in the Town of Morris, on the Third Friday in each Month, at the hour of ~~Ten~~ ^{9/16} 10 o'clock ^{AM}, and if there is no quorum at the expiration of Two hours after the time appointed for the meeting, the Council shall stand adjourned to the next regular Meeting thereof, and the Clerk shall enter in the Minutes, the names of the Members present.

The Reeve of the Municipality shall preside at all Meetings of the Council, or in his absence the Members of the Council present, may, Fifteen Minutes after the appointed time, appoint a chairman from those present, who shall have the same authority and exercise the same functions, in presiding, as the Reeve would have.

Should the Reeve or any of the Councillors be appointed by resolution to go to Winnipeg or any other place on business of the Municipality, they shall be paid the sum of \$ 4.00 per day and actual travelling expenses.

The Reeve and any of the Councillors shall be paid \$ 4.00 per day and Ten cents per Mile necessarily travelled for inspection, or in performing work or other service in respect to roads, bridges, or other public works in or for the Municipality, providing that all amounts for such work be verified by a statutory Declaration which has been filed with the Clerk of the Municipality, and a resolution of the Council passed, authorizing payment of same, as well as previous authority from the Council to do the work.
