

BY - LAW NO. 717.

By-Law # 717 of the Rural Municipality of Morris, being a By-Law for the purpose of confirming the appointment and fixing the salary of the Secretary-Treasurer for the year 1947.

Whereas it is deemed expedient by By-Law to confirm the appointment and fix the Salary of the Secretary-Treasurer and to define the duties of the said Official.

Now therefore be it enacted, and it is hereby enacted as and for By-Law # 717 of the Rural Municipality of Morris as follows:-

That *Jas. L. Pottinger* be and is hereby appointed Secretary-Treasurer of the Rural Municipality of Morris for the year A.D. 1947 at a Salary of \$160.00 per Month, and he shall perform all the duties required of him by the Municipal Act.

He shall be entitled to receive for his own use, all fees for searches and Certificates Etc., in connection with his office, and if required, shall put up all notices, superintend the letting of and completion of all contracts, for which he shall be paid 10 cents per Mile necessarily travelled each way, or if he should necessarily go outside the Municipality on business for the corporation, his actual expenses in connection with same shall be paid.
