

By-Law No.719 of the Rural Municipality of Morris.

Whereas "The Municipal Act" requires every Municipal Corporation on or before the last day of February in each year, to make estimates of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation for the year in which such sums are required to be levied, and to pay all its' debts falling due within the year, making due allowances for Taxes imposed on lands purchased by the Corporation at Tax-Sale and considered uncollectable and for the cost of collection and abatement and losses which may occur in the collection of Taxes, which allowance is hereinafter referred to as Tax reserve;

And Whereas the Rural Municipality of Morris has made estimates of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the corporation for the year 1947, excepting for that of schools, as the Department of Education and the Premier of the Province have advised of a definite change in Provincial Financial assistance to education for the year 1947.

And Whereas it is necessary by By-Law or By-Laws to levy a rate or rates of so much on the dollar upon the assessed value of all rateable property liable therefor in the Municipality as the Council deems sufficient to raise the sums required for the Lawful purposes of the Corporation as shown by the estimates;

And Whereas the assessed value of the whole rateable property within the Rural Municipality of Morris according to the last revised assessment roll is- \$ 4,255,030.00.

And Whereas it is necessary to fix the rates of taxation for the purposes aforesaid and the time for payment of all rates and Taxes so fixed and levied;

Now Therefore the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris in Council assembled, enacts as follows:

Estimates.

1. That the estimates of the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation for the year 1947 as set out in Schedule "A" hereof and identified by the signature of the head of the Council and the Chairman of the Finance Committee are hereby approved.

Uncontrollable Purposes.

2. That the following respective Mill Rates be and are hereby levied for the year 1947 upon the assessed value of all rateable property in the Municipality respectively liable therefor according to the last revised General and Personal Property Assessment Rolls thereof, to raise the sums required for the uncontrollable purposes of the Corporation, which said rates, assessed values and sums required are set out in Schedule "A", viz:

(a) A general rate of 8.00 Mills on the dollar to provide for the payment to each and every School District in the Municipality as provided under the new Financial assistance.

(b) The following respective special rates of so many Mills on the Dollar, viz:

on property assessed as set out in Column 2, to provide for the payment of the respective sums of money set out in Column 5, being the amount estimated as respectively required as a special levy in addition to the Provincial and Municipal support, by each of the School Districts named in Column 1 of part 2 of Schedule "A"

(c) A general rate of 3.5 Mills on the Dollar to provide for the payment of the amount mentioned and apportioned to the Municipality in the Statement of the Municipal Commissioner under "The Municipal Act", as set out in Column 2 of Part 1 of Schedule "A".

(d) Provide for the necessary Drainage Maintenance Levies as set out in Column 2 of Schedule "A". 2 Mills on the Dollar.

(e) Provide for uncontrollable local improvement levies on Sperling, Lowe Farm, Kane, and Aubigny, and any other districts requiring same.

(f) Provide for Rink levy in connection with Sperling Rink.

(g) A general rate of 16.5 Mills on the Dollar to provide for the payment of Drainage Debentures in full, as set out in Column 2 of Schedule "A".

(h) A general rate of 5.5 Mills on the Dollar to provide for the Drainage Over-Expenditure of 1946, balance of same to be met by Monies to be received by the Provincial Government.

(g) Provide for Hospital levies in connection with Carman & Altona Districts.

Controllable Purposes.

3. (a) That a general rate of 12. Mills on the Dollar made up of the rate or rates specified in Column 5, be and is hereby levied for the year 1947 upon the assessed value of all the rateable property in the Municipality liable therefor, according to the last revised general and personal property Assessment Rolls thereof to provide for:

The payment of the amount estimated as required for the general controllable purposes of the Corporation viz: Public Works, Protection of Persons and Property, Social Services, Miscellaneous Purposes, Depreciation and Administration, as set out in Column 2 of Part 1 of Schedule "A".

Payment of Taxes.

4. That all Taxes and rates imposed and levied in the Rural Municipality of Morris for the year 1947 shall be deemed to have been imposed and to be due and payable on or before the Thirty-first day of October A.D. 1947.
