

BY-LAW No. 720  
of The Rural Municipality of Morris  
Re: Moving buildings within the  
Municipality.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of  
Morris, in Council assembled, enacts as follows:-

1. No person shall move or cause to be moved, on, along, or across any highway, any structure, building, house or any other object not authorized to be on the highway by "The Highway Traffic Act of Manitoba" being Chap. 93 R. S. M. 1940 and amendments thereto, without first obtaining from the Secretary-treasurer of the Municipality a permit for such moving.
2. An application for any such permit must be made to the Secretary-treasurer of the Municipality in writing, signed by the person responsible for such moving, and must contain full particulars of the building or object to be moved, the proposed method of moving, the location, proposed destination and route to be taken or followed and any further or other information as may be required by the Council of the Rural Municipality.
3. In granting such Permit the Municipality may require such moving to be carried out under such conditions as it may impose, and may require that adequate arrangements be made with the proper authority in connection with the crossing of or passing under any telegraph, telephone or electric power lines, or the moving into another municipality. The Municipality may require the person or persons applying for such permit to enter into an agreement in writing, or furnish a cash deposit, bond or other security, as may be deemed proper, to protect the Municipality against any claim or claims in respect of damage to the highway or liability for obstruction to the highway, or against any claim or claims whatsoever which may be made against the Municipality as a result of said moving.

4. Any permit so granted must be made in writing and signed by the Secretary-treasurer of the Municipality, and said permit must be carried at all times with the building or object being moved.

5. In this by-law "Highway" means and includes any highway as defined in the aforesaid "Highway Traffic Act" and over which the Municipality has authority as provided in said Act. In this by-law PERSON means and includes any firm or corporation.

6. Any person contravening any provision of this by-law or contravening any of the terms or conditions, under and by which any permit is granted shall be liable to a fine not exceeding One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

7. A fee of \$1.00 will be paid to the Secretary-treasurer of the Municipality on issuance of any such permit.
