

BY-LAW NO. 729

A By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris for submitting By-Law No. 728 to the electors, which said By-Law No. 728 relates to the creation of a debt of \$5,217.30 annually for the purpose of constructing, equipping, and maintaining a Hospital under "The Health Services Act".

WHEREAS By-Law No. 728 of the Rural Municipality of Morris ~~introduced~~ entitled, "A By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris to authorize the annual levy of \$5,217.30, for the purpose of constructing, equipping, and maintaining a Hospital under "The Health Services Act", has been introduced and read a first and second time by the Municipal Council of the said Rural Municipality of Morris;
n NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris in session assembled enacts as follows:

1. The said By-Law No. 728 shall be submitted to the electors qualified to vote thereon on the 24th day of October, A.D. 1947, and for the purpose of taking the votes thereon the Polls shall be open between the hours of nine o'clock (9) A.M. and five o'clock (5) P.M. of the said date at the following places, namely:

(a) Ward One, Poll # 1-All duly qualified electors of of the said Ward, excepting thereout, Sections 2, 3 & 4 in Township 4, range 1W., with polling booth at Broadview School House.

(b) Ward Two, Poll # 1-All duly qualified electors of said Ward living East of the C.P.R. line, with polling booth at Mrs. Robert Taylors' house, N.E. 24-5-1E. Poll # 2- ~~All~~ duly qualified electors of said ~~part~~ Ward living west of the C.P.R. line, at Rosenhoff School House- Sec. 20-5-1E.

(c) Ward Three, poll # 1, All duly qualified Electors of said Ward living East of the C.P.R. line, with polling booth at ~~Lea Bank School House~~. Poll # 2, All duly qualified Electors of said Ward living West of the C.P.R. line, with polling booth at Lea Bank School House.

(d) Ward Four, Poll # 1, -All duly qualified Electors of the said Ward living South of the division line between Townships Five and Six, with polling booth at Amour School House. Poll # 2-All duly qualified Electors of said Ward living North of the division line between Townships Five and Six, with polling place at Provencher School House.

(e) Ward Five- Poll # 1-All duly qualified Electors of said Ward living in the North half of the said Ward, with polling place at Lowe Farm School House. Poll # 2-All duly qualified Electors of the said Ward living in the South half of said Ward excepting thereout Sections 5 & 6 in Township 4 Range 1W. and Sections, 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5 in Township 4, Range 2W., with polling place at Rosefarm School House.

(f) Ward Six- Poll # 1- All duly qualified Electors of the said Ward, excepting thereout Township 6, Range 2W., with the polling booth at the Orange Hall in the Village of Speeling.

2. On the 23rd day of October, A.D. 1947, at the hour of three (3) o'clock in the afternoon the Reeve of the said Rural Municipality of Morris shall attend at the Municipal Office for the purpose of appointing persons to attend at the said Polling places and also to attend at the official summing up of the votes hereinafter referred to by the Secretary-Treasurer, on behalf of the persons interested in the said By-Law and of promoting or opposing the passing of the said By-Law respectively.

3. On the 25th day of October, A.D. 1947, the Clerk of the Municipality will attend at the Municipal Office at the hour of ten (10) o'clock in the forenoon, to sum up the number of votes for and against the said By-Law.
