

By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris for constructing, opening and making a drain over and across Sections Twenty-nine and Thirty both in Township Four and Range Two, West of the Principal Meridian in the Province of Manitoba.

Whereas it is necessary and advisable to construct, open and make a drain over and across Sections Twenty-nine (29) and Thirty (30) both in Township Four (4) and Range Two (2) West of the Principal Meridian in the Province of Manitoba, in order that the said land and other lands may be benefited, and it is deemed necessary to enter upon, break up, acquire, take and use certain lands necessary or desirable for such purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris in Session assembled enacts as follows-

(1) That a drain be constructed, opened and made, over and across Sections Twenty-nine (29) and Thirty (30) both in Township Four (4) and Range Two (2) West of the Principal Meridian, in the Province of Manitoba, in accordance with a Plan of Survey made by G.A. Warrington, Manitoba Land Surveyor, and sworn to on the 6th day of April A.D. 1948.

(2) That the lands shewn coloured pink on said plan be entered upon, broken up, acquired and taken for that purpose.

(3) That the officers of the Municipality be and they are hereby authorized to take all the necessary steps,

(a) to obtain Title to the lands coloured pink shewn on said Plan in the name of the Rural Municipality of Morris, either by obtaining a conveyance from the owners of said lands, or by expropriating said lands under the Provisions of "The Expropriation Act", and

(b) to pay to the owners of said lands such compensation as may be agreed upon between the council and the said owners, or such amount as may be fixed by arbitration under the provisions of "The Expropriation Act" and "The Arbitration Act".
