

BY-LAW NO 7421

of the Rural Municipality of Morris  
respecting the Licensing of Pool  
and Billiard Rooms.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 937 (a) of the Municipal Act, being Cap 141.R.S.M. 1940, it is enacted that the Council of every Municipality may pass by-laws for licensing, limiting, regulating and governing all persons who for hire or gain, either directly or indirectly, keep or have in their possession or on their premises any Billiard, Pool or Bagatelle Table, in a place of entertainment or resort, which is open to the public, whether such Billiard, Pool or Bagatelle Table is used or not and for fixing the sum to be paid for a license to have or keep such Billiard, Pool or Bagatelle Table and the time such license shall be in force.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that due provision shall be made for the licensing of such tables as aforesaid.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris duly assembled enacts as follows-

1. As at from and after the passing of this by-law it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to keep or have in their possession or on their premises within the Rural Municipality of Morris in Manitoba, for hire or gain, either directly or indirectly, any Billiard, Pool or Bagatelle Table or Tables, whether such tables are used or not, except such person or persons have first procured as license as hereinafter provided.
2. That the Secretary-Treasurer of the Rural Municipality of Morris is hereby empowered to grant a license to any such person or persons so desiring to have or keep such table or tables, hereinbefore referred to, within the Rural Municipality of Morris in Manitoba upon payment of a license fee of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars for the first table so kept and Ten (\$10.00) Dollars for each additional table so kept. And further that said license so issued shall remain in force and effect for a period of twelve months from date of issuance.
3. That all places in the said Rural Municipality used as a Billiard, Pool or Bagatelle Room shall have no obstruction of any kind or nature covering the windows of such room so as to obstruct the view of the proceedings carried on by any person or persons therein.
4. That such room so used shall not be kept open between the hours of eleven o'clock on Saturday night until eight o'clock on the following Monday morning and on other nights from the hours of eleven o'clock at night until eight o'clock the following morning.
5. That the penalty for any infraction or infractions of this by-law shall be the penalties so provided by an Act respecting Billiard and Pool Rooms and being Cap.15.R.S.M.1940.
6. This by-law shall rescind and revoke all or any by-law or by-laws previously passed by the Rural Municipality of Morris concerning Billiard, Pool and Bagatelle Tables and the keeping thereof,
