

BY LAW NO 749<sup>1</sup>  
of the Rural Municipality of Morris.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is the owner of Lots Fifty-two (52) to Fifty-five (55) both inclusive which Lots are shewn on a Plan of Survey of Part of Lot Twelve (12) of the Parish of Saint James in Manitoba, registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No 1365 and William Openshaw of 471 Walker Avenue, in the City of Winnipeg in the Province of Manitoba, Canadian National Railway Constable and his wife Gladys Florence Openshaw of the same place, have offered to purchase the aforesaid property.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted and it is hereby enacted that the Rural Municipality of Morris sell the aforesaid property hereinbefore referred to, to William Openshaw and his wife as Joint Tenants and not as Tenants in Common at and for the price of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars and that the proper officers be authorized to execute the necessary conveyance.
