

Official Trustee  
By-law of the ~~School Trustees~~ for the School District of Lone Star  
No. 1629, for the purpose of borrowing the sum of EIGHT THOUSAND (\$8,000.00)  
\_\_\_\_\_ Dollars and of issuing debentures therefor.

WHEREAS it is necessary and expedient to raise by loan the sum of EIGHT THOUSAND (\$8,000.00) Dollars on the credit of the said School District, for the purpose of erecting a school building

THEREFORE, the ~~School Trustees~~ <sup>Official Trustee</sup> for the School District of Lone Star No. 1629, duly assembled, enact as follows:

(1) That it shall be lawful for the said ~~School Trustees~~ <sup>Official Trustee</sup> to borrow the sum of EIGHT THOUSAND (\$8,000.00) Dollars by the issue and sale of debentures of the said School District as set out below:

(2) That the said debentures shall be issued at Winnipeg, Manitoba. and shall bear date the 1st day of August A.D. 1949 and shall be payable to the bearer at Royal Bank of Canada <sup>Main Office</sup> at Winnipeg in the Province of Manitoba as follows: the debentures shall be so issued that the amount thereby borrowed shall be repayable in 10 equalized consecutive annual instalments of \$986.33 Dollars each, including principal and interest at the rate of 4% per cent per annum. The first of said instalments may be increased or decreased by the amount of interest necessary to cover the case where the time between date of issue and date of the first payment exceeds or is less than one year, the amount of the said first instalment being \$986.33 Dollars.

(3) That the first debenture shall be payable the 1st day of August A.D. 1950.

(4) That each debenture shall be signed by the ~~Secretary-Treasurer and counter-signed by one of the Trustees~~ <sup>Official Trustee</sup> of the said School District.

(5) That provision shall be made out of the annual school taxes for the payment of the said debentures, and such provision shall form part of, and be included in the annual statements of monies required for the purposes of the School District.

PUBLIC NOTICE.

Under "The Municipal Act" and "The Public Schools Act".

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that By-Law No 1/49 of the School District of Lone Star No 1629, Manitoba, will be submitted to a vote of the electors of the said School District of Lone Star No.1629, entitled to vote thereon under the provisions of the above Acts, at the time and place hereinafter mentioned.

The purpose of the said By-law No 1/49 of the said School District so to be submitted is to raise the sum of Eight Thousand (\$8000.00) Dollars for the purpose of erecting a school building, and issuance and sale of debentures for such purpose. The Debentures shall be issued at the City of Winnipeg in the Province of Manitoba and bear date the 1st day of August A.D.1949 and shall be repayable to the bearer at the Royal Bank of Canada at its main office in Winnipeg Manitoba in ten equal annual consecutive instalments of \$986.33 each including principal and interest at the rate of 4% per annum. The first debenture shall be payable on the 1st day of August A.D.1950, said first instalment being \$986.33. The time and place for taking the vote of the electors for and against said by-law No.1/49 is Monday the 12th day of September A.D.1949 between the hours of 9.00 o'clock in the forenoon and 8.00 o'clock in the afternoon. Standard Time, and the polling place shall be the Lone Star School House in the Province of Manitoba. The Reeve of the Municipality of Morris, at the Council Chambers at the Town of Morris in the Province of Manitoba, shall on Tuesday the 8th day of September A.D.1949 at the hour of 3.00 o'clock in the afternoon (if requested so to do) appoint persons to attend at the polling place and at the final summing up of the votes by the Clerk, on behalf of the persons interested in the said By-Law to promote or oppose the passage of same. The Clerk of the said Municipality will attend at his office in the Town of Morris in the Province of Manitoba on Tuesday the 13th day of September at the hour of 9.00 o'clock in the forenoon and will sum up the votes for and against the said by-law.

A copy of said by-law is on file at the Municipal Office Morris Manitoba, and may be inspected by interested parties at all reasonable hours before the vote thereon is taken.
