

BY-LAW NO. 766

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the sale of Part of the South West Quarter of Section Twenty-nine (29) in Township Six (6) and Range Two (2) West of the Principal Meridian in the Province of Manitoba.

WHEREAS the said Municipality is the owner of the following property to wit-

" All that portion of the South West Quarter of Section Twenty-nine (29) in Township Six (6) and Range Two (2) West of the Principal Meridian in the Province of Manitoba, described as follows, Commencing at a point on the South side of Station Street in the Village of Sperling where the said South side of Station Street is intersected by the West side of the lane running Northward along the West side of Block Three (3), as said Station Street, Lane and Block are shewn on a Plan of Survey of said Village of Sperling registered in the Carman Land Titles Office as No. 916; thence Westerly along the said South side of Station Street Forty (40) feet, thence Southerly parallel to the said Lane One Hundred (100) feet, thence Easterly parallel to said Station Street Forty (40) feet to the Western limit of said Lane to the point of commencement".

AND WHEREAS the said Municipality has had an offer to purchase the aforesaid property from one, Bodin Kasjan, of the Village of Sperling in Manitoba, Barber at and for the cash price of One Hundred and Twenty-five (\$125.00) Dollars.

AND WHEREAS the said Municipality deems the above price to be a fair and reasonable one.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED that the said Municipality sell the aforesaid property to the said Bodin Kasjan at and for the sum of One Hundred and Twenty-Five (\$125.00) Dollars cash and that the necessary transfer be prepared forthwith.
