

BY-LAW No. 771 of the Rural Municipality of Morris.

BY-LAW No. 771, being a BY-LAW of the Rural Municipality of Morris to provide for polling places for election of Reeve for the said Rural Municipality of Morris for the years A.D. 1952 and 1953.

NOW Therefore, in pursuance with the provisions of the "Municipal Act" and amendments thereto, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris enacts that the polling places for the above mentioned election shall be as follows:

(a) WARD ONE - Poll # 1 - All duly qualified electors of that portion of Ward one of the R.M. of Morris, lying East of the Principal Meridian, shall vote at a poll to be in the Broadview School House, if they vote. Poll # 2 - All duly qualified electors of Ward one in the Rural Municipality of Morris, lying West of the Principal Meridian, shall if voting, vote at a poll to be held in the St. Peter's School House.

(B) WARD TWO - Poll # 1 - All duly qualified electors of that portion of Ward ~~Two~~ of the R.M. of Morris, lying West of the C.P.R. Railway line, shall if voting, vote at a poll to be held in the Rosenhoff School house. Poll # 2 - All duly qualified electors of that portion of Ward two of the R.M. of Morris, lying East of the C.P.R. line, shall if voting, vote at a poll to be held in Taylors' residence N.E. 25-5-1E.


(c) WARD THREE - Poll # 1 - All duly qualified electors of that portion of Ward three lying East of the C.P.R. line in the P.M. of Morris, shall if voting, vote at a poll to be held in Pellands' store at Silver Plains. Poll # 2 - All duly qualified electors of that portion of Ward three of the R.M. of Morris, lying West of the C.P.R. line, shall if voting, vote at a poll to be held in the ~~Green~~ Bank School House.


(d) WARD Four - Poll # 1 - All duly qualified electors of that portion of Ward four lying North of a line drawn East and West between River Lots 416 and 418 in the R.M. of Morris, shall if voting, vote at a poll to be held in the Provencher School House. Poll # 2 - All duly qualified Electors of that portion of Ward four of the R.M. of Morris lying South of a line drawn East and West between River Lots 416 and 418, shall if voting, vote at a poll to be held in the Armour School House.

(e) WARD Five - Poll # 1 - All duly qualified electors of that portion of Ward five of the R.M. of Morris lying North of a line drawn East and West Equidistant from the North and South Boundaries of Township Four, shall if voting, vote at a poll to be held in the Lowe Farm School House. Poll # 2 - All duly qualified electors of that portion of Ward five of the R.M. of Morris lying South of a line drawn East and West equidistant from the North and South Boundaries of Township four, shall if voting, vote at a poll to be held in the Rosefarm School house.

(f) Ward Six - Poll # 1 - All duly qualified Electors of that portion of ward six of the R.M. of Morris lying North of a line drawn between Townships five and six, shall if voting, vote at a poll to be held in the Orange Hall in the Village of Sperling. Poll # 2 - All duly qualified electors of that portion of Ward six in the R.M. of Morris lying South of Township Six, shall if voting, vote at a poll to be held at the Neufeld School house.
