

BY-LAW NO 222 <sup>1</sup>

A By-law of the Rural Municipality of Morris to authorize the payment of Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars to Henry W. Reimer, as compensation for the appropriation of certain lanes and streets.

WHEREAS Henry W. Reimer, of the Postal District of Abbotsford, in British Columbia, Farmer, as Executor of the last will and testament of Jacob J. Reimer, late of the Village of Lowe Farm, in Manitoba, Retired Farmer, Deceased, is the registered owner of certain lands described as follows:-

Part of the South East Quarter of Section Six,  
in Township Five, Range One West.

AND WHEREAS a plan of subdivision was registered in the Modern Land Titles Office as No 510 creating certain various Streets, Avenues and Lanes, in the Village of Lowe Farm, respecting the said land.

AND WHEREAS the Crown in the right of the Province became the owner of these various Streets, Avenues and Lanes by virtue of The Manitoba Expropriation Act Sec. 38 Cap. 68. R.S.M. 1940.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris in Council assembled enacts as follows:-

THAT the Rural Municipality of Morris pay the said Henry W. Reimer the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars as compensation for the said expropriation.

THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer of the said Municipality are hereby authorized and empowered to do all things necessary or desired in connection with the foregoing.
