

BY-LAW NO. 275

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the licensing of Transient Traders, Hawkers, Pedlars, Petty Chapmen and Salesmen doing business within the Corporate limits of said Rural Municipality.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and advisable to pass a by-law relative to the licensing, controlling and regulating of all persons who sell goods, merchandise and effects of any kind within the confines of the Corporation, direct to the consumer and not ~~have~~^{having} his or their principal place of business within the Corporation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED and it is hereby enacted pursuant to Section 935 of the Municipal Act being Cap 141, R.S.M. and amendments thereto, as follows-

No Transient Trader, Hawker, Pedlar, Petty Chapman, Salesman, or other person or persons shall sell any goods, wares, merchandise or effects of any kind, or offer the same for sale by sample cards, specimen or otherwise, within the Corporate limits of the Rural Municipality of Morris, for or on account of any retail merchant, retail manufacturer or other persons selling direct to the consumer and not having his principal place of business within the Corporation, or who whether acting for themselves or as agents for other persons, take orders for any goods or for any finished article whatsoever which have been or are to be manufactured, made or completed in whole or in part in some place outside the limits of the Corporation by any retail merchant, manufacturer or other person not having his or its principal place of business within such limits or who delivers such manufactured, made or completed goods or articles, without first applying for and taking out a license from the Secretary-Treasurer of the Rural Municipality of Morris.

"Corporation" shall mean and include all territory within the confines of the Rural Municipality of Morris in the Province of Manitoba.

The fee for said license hereinbefore referred to shall be in the amount of \$25.00 and shall be in force and effective for a period of twelve months and to be applied and paid for on or before the 31st day of January in any year.

Any person or persons, failing to comply with the requirements of this by-law in respect to the taking out of said license, shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$10.00 and not more than \$50.00, and costs, recoverable on Summary Conviction before a Justice of the Peace or Police Magistrate, and in default of payment to imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty days.
