WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to purchase the following land to wit, Lots Eleven (11) and ~~Twelve (12)~~ in Block Three (3) as shown on a Plan of Survey of Part of the Village of Lowe Farm in the Province of Manitoba, registered in the Morden Land Titles Office as No. 522., for the purpose, of at a later ~~later~~ date, erecting a fire hall thereon.

AND WHEREAS Abram K. Klassen of the Village of Lowe Farm in Manitoba, Teamster, is presently the owner of said land and has offered to sell same to the Rural Municipality of Morris at and for the sum of \$500.00.

AND WHEREAS the Council deem said offer to be a fair and reasonable one.

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted, and it is hereby enacted in Council duly assembled, pursuant to 393 (A) of the Municipal Act, Cap 141, R.S.M. Manitoba and amendments thereto, that the Rural Municipality purchase the above property from the said Abram K. Klassen at and for the sum of \$500.00 and that the necessary documents be drawn and executed forthwith.
