

By-Law No. 783 of the Rural Municipality of Morris

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to open a road through Sections one (1) and Twelve (12) in Township four (4) and Range one (1) West of the Principal Meridian and Sections seven (7) and Seventeen (17) and eighteen (18) in Township four (4) and Range one (1) East of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, along the Right-of-way of the Canadian Pacific Railway as shown on plan made by Thomas Ralph Miller, Manitoba Land Surveyor, and sworn the 3rd day of October, 1952.

NOW, ~~THEREFORE~~, be it enacted as by-law No. 783 of the Rural Municipality of Morris as follows:

1. THAT a road be opened through Sections one (1) and twelve (12) in Township four (4) and Range one (1) West and through Section seven (7) and Seventeen (17) and Eighteen (18) in Township four (4) and Range one (1) East of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, as shown on a plan of survey made by Thomas Ralph Miller, Manitoba Land Surveyor, and sworn the 3rd day of October, 1952.

2. THAT compensation be paid to the said owners at the rate of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars per acre.

DONE AND PASSED at a meeting of the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris, held on the 13th day of February, 1953.
