

BY-LAW NO. 786

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the purchase of land for the establishing and maintenance of a Nuisance Ground.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to purchase land for the use and purpose of a Nuisance Ground and the maintenance of same.

AND WHEREAS St. John's College is presently the registered owner of the following land, to wit, " The most Southerly Four Hundred and Seventeen and four-tenths feet in depth of the most Easterly Four Hundred and Seventeen and four-tenths feet in width of the South East Quarter of Section Twenty-one (21) in Township Six (6) and Range Two (2) West of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba.

AND WHEREAS the aforesaid property has been sold under and by virtue of an Agreement for Sale to one, H.M. Fewster of Sperling in Manitoba, who has in turn filed a Caveat against said property.

AND WHEREAS both St. John's College and the said H.M. Fewster are both in agreement for the sale of the aforesaid property to the Rural Municipality of Morris at and for the sum of \$600.00

AND WHEREAS said price is deemed a fair and reasonable one.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted and it is hereby enacted that the Rural Municipality of Morris purchase the above property at and for the sum of \$600.00 pursuant to Section 393 S.S. (e) of the Municipal Act being R.S.M. 141 and amendments thereto and that the necessary documents be prepared for receiving Title thereto.
