

BY-LAW NO. 788

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the purchase of land for storage and maintenance purposes for Municipal machinery and equipment.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to purchase land for the aforesaid purposes/

AND WHEREAS Lawrence Gruenke of the Municipality of Morris in Manitoba is the owner of the following land, to wit,

Those portions of River Lots Three Hundred and Thirty-seven (337) and Three Hundred and Thirty-nine (339) in the Parish of Ste. Agathe in the Province of Manitoba, which Lots are shown on a plan of Special Survey registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 3799 and bounded as follows; on the South by the Southern limit of said River Lot Three Hundred and Thirty-seven (337), on the North by a straight line drawn north of parallel with and perpendicularly distant nine hundred and forty-seven (947) feet from said Southern limit and on the East and West by two straight lines drawn North from and at right angles to said Southern limit from two points in said Southern limit distant Westerly thereon Five Hundred and Sixty feet and Seven Hundred and Sixty Feet respectively from the Westerly limit of land taken for the right-of-way of the Canadian Pacific Railway as same is shown on a Plan of Survey registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No. 374.

AND WHEREAS the owner of the aforesaid property is desirous of selling same to the Rural Municipality of Morris at and or the price of \$652.50 and the said Municipality deems said sum to be a fair and reasonable consideration.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted and it is hereby enacted pursuant to 393 of the Municipal Act and amendments thereto that the Municipality of Morris purchase the aforesaid property from Lawrence Gruenke at and for the sum of \$652.50 and that the necessary documents be prepared forthwith.
