THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A HOSPITAL DISTRICT  
pursuant to "The Health Services Act".

By-law No. 795 of the Rural Municipality  
Urban  
of Morris made pursuant

to the provisions of "The Health Services Act", ratifying  
and confirming establishment of ~~hospital~~ <sup>further</sup> facilities for  
the area or district hereinafter more particularly delimited  
and described.

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of section 33 of The Health  
Services Act the Minister has prepared a plan for ~~a~~ <sup>further</sup> Hospital ~~District~~ <sup>facilities</sup>  
~~for The Carman~~ for The Carman Hospital District

AND WHEREAS the ~~Organization Committee~~ <sup>Governing Board</sup> appointed pursuant to  
~~supplementary~~ <sup>supplementary</sup> said Act has prepared a <sup>further</sup> scheme for the establishment of hospital  
facilities for said district and the same has been approved by the  
Minister.

AND WHEREAS the Minister has submitted said <sup>supplementary</sup> scheme to this  
Municipality.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that a by-law ratifying the  
<sup>supplementary</sup> said scheme and authorizing the borrowing of the money required be  
passed and submitted for the assent of the resident ratepayers in the  
included area within this Municipality.

AND WHEREAS the whole of the rateable land of the Rural  
Municipality of Morris according to the last revised  
assessment roll thereof is in the amount of \_\_\_\_\_  
Dollars (\$ 4,384,270<sup>00</sup> ).

AND WHEREAS the existing debenture debt of the said Municipality,  
exclusive of local improvement debentures secured by special assess-  
ments therefor, amount to nil  
Dollars (\$ nil ) whereof no portion of  
either the principal or interest is in arrear.

THEREFORE, the Rural Municipality of Morris

in Council assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT, pursuant to "The Health Services Act",

- ~~K. a Hospital District be established on the basis of said~~  
~~scheme, a copy of which is attached hereto~~  
**supplementary** **further**
1. ~~X~~ the **V**scheme, as set out for the establishment of **V**hospital facilities for the said Hospital District, be ratified and approved, (which said **V**scheme attached hereto shall, for all purposes, be deemed to be, and is a part of this by-law):
  2. ~~X~~ This Municipality approves and agrees to, and authorizes the Board,
    - (a) by resolution to authorize its chairman and secretary-treasurer to borrow, from time to time, such sums as the Board deems necessary to meet the expenditure of the District, until such time as the taxes for the then current year are received; the amounts so borrowed shall be a charge upon the taxes due to the Hospital District, and further approves of the Board, by its proper officers, giving and executing promissory note or notes, of the Board, as security for money so borrowed:
    - (b) by resolution to authorize the issue of debentures to secure the amount of principal borrowed on account of capital expenditure, and interest on the borrowed principal; said debenture to bind, and form a lien and charge against all hospital property in the District, and all taxes levied in the District for the payment thereof:
  3. ~~X~~ For purposes of meeting the liability of the Municipality to the Board for its apportioned share of annual contribution to the refunding of capital expenditure, and the maintenance and operation of said **Hospital**, **there be** levied and collected annually, **facilities**

as a special rate, a Hospital tax from all lands and property in this Municipality lying within said Hospital District, sufficient to provide the amount necessary to pay the Municipality's apportionment to the Board, and the proper officers of the Municipality are authorized and empowered to make said levy or levies, to collect said taxes and pay the proceeds so collected to the Board.

4. ~~5.~~ The proper officers of the Municipality are empowered to do all acts and things, and to execute all documents requisite to the carrying out of said <sup>supplementary</sup> scheme and of those by-laws:

5. ~~6.~~ The definition of any expression contained in "The Health Services Act" or "The Manitoba Interpretation Act", shall extend and apply to the same or like expression wherever used in this by-law; and the word "ACT" as used throughout this by-law means "The Health Services Act", S.M.

SUPPLEMENTARY SCHEME FOR THE CARMAN MEMORIAL HOSPITAL

DISTRICT NO. 20

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The Governing Board established pursuant to the provisions of "The Health Services Act" has formulated a Supplementary Scheme for the establishment of further facilities for the Hospital District, and beg to submit for your consideration the following Supplementary Scheme:

The purpose and content of this Supplementary Scheme is to amend the original Scheme by providing for the establishment of a Medical Nursing Unit in the Unincorporated Village of St. Claude, and provides:

1. THAT the definition of any expression contained in "The Health Services Act", and "The Manitoba Interpretation Act", extend and apply to the same or like expression wherever used in this Supplementary Scheme, and the word "Act" wherever used throughout this Scheme means "The Health Services Act".

2. THAT the areas and equalized assessments be as in the original Scheme except for the Rural Municipality of Roland which has been reduced by the subtraction of the north half of Township 4, Range 3 West, and more specifically set out as follows:

(i) All of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin, with an equalized assessment of	\$4,169,000.00
(ii) All of the Incorporated Town of Carman, with an equalized assessment of	497,000.00
(iii) All of the Rural Municipality of Grey, excepting Township 9, Range 3W, with an estimated equalized assessment of	2,278,168.00
(iv) All of Township 5, Range 3W, all of Township 5, Range 4W, the north half of Township 4, Range 4W, and the east half of Township 5, Range 5W, Sections 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 34, 35, 36, in Township 4, Range 5W;  All in the Rural Municipality of Roland, with an estimated equalized assessment of	2,102,515.00
(v) The West half of Township 5, Range 5W, All of Township 5, Range 6W, All of Township 5, Range 7W, The south half of Township 6, Range 7W  All in the Rural Municipality of Thompson, with an estimated equalized assessment of	1,328,400.00
(vi) The east half of Township 5, Range 8W, The east half of Township 6, Range 8W,  All in the Rural Municipality of Lorne, with an estimated equalized assessment of	246,900.00
(vii) All of Township 6, Range 2W, in the Rural Municipality of Morris, with an estimated equalized assessment of	509,168.00
(viii) All of Township 7, Range 2W, in the Rural Municipality of MacDonald, with an estimated equalized assessment of	414,924.00
Estimated total equalized assessment for Hospital District	<hr style="width: 100%; border: 0.5px solid black;"/> \$11,546,075.00

3. THAT a Medical Nursing Unit shall be established in the Unincorporated Village of St. Claude, providing for:

- (a) 6 to 8 beds, and an emergency room,
- (b) a delivery room and nursery with 4 bassinets in cubicles,
- (c) office space for one physician,
- (d) quarters for 5 nursing staff.

4. THAT the estimated cost for establishing the Unit being \$60,000.00, to which the construction grants of the Federal and Provincial Governments of \$25,666.66, and the donations of the Manitoba Pool Elevators of \$3,000.00, and community donations of at least \$6,333.34, shall be first applied, leaving the maximum capital liability of the District for the establishing of the Unit at \$25,000.00.

5. THAT in order to provide funds for the establishment of the Unit mentioned in Paragraph 3, the Board by sale of debentures or other forms of borrowing shall procure the \$25,000.00, or any portion thereof, and the repayment of such borrowings shall be over a period not exceeding 20 years from the date of issue or effect, and the rate of interest shall not exceed five per centum (5%) per annum.

6. THAT the capital and annual liabilities be apportioned amongst the included municipalities in accordance with the original Scheme; the Unincorporated Village of St. Claude \* being responsible for ten percent (10%) of the liability in the first instance, and the remaining ninety percent (90%) apportioned over the District in the ratio of the equalized assessment of the included areas as set out hereunder:

\* For the purpose of this Supplementary Scheme, the Unincorporated Village of St. Claude shall be the Local Improvement District as established by By-Law No. 366 of the Rural Municipality of Grey.

7. THAT the annual expenditure incident to the operation of the Unit be estimated at \$15,000.00, and the annual revenue derived therefrom at \$13,500.00.

8. THAT the annual deficit, if any, be levied over the Hospital District on the same basis as the capital liability; that is, 10% on the Unincorporated Village of St. Claude, and the remaining 90% over the whole Hospital District.
