

BY-LAW NO. 797.

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the purchase of land for the establishing of a nuisance ground.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to purchase land for the use and purpose of a Nuisance Ground within the confines of the said Municipality.


AND WHEREAS Peter.K.Loewen of the Post Office of McTavish in Manitoba, Farmer, is the owner of the following land, to wit, all that portion of the East Half of Legal Subdivision Nine (9) and all that portion of Legal Subdivision Ten (10) of Section Nine (9) in Township Six (6) and Range One (1) East of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba; and Peter.B. Dueck, of the Post Office of Rosenort in Manitoba, Farmer, is the owner of the following land, to wit, all that portion of the West Half of Legal Subdivision Nine (9) in the aforesaid Section Nine (9), as both are shewn colored Pink on a Plan of same made by Charles Dudley Brown, Manitoba Land Surveyor, and sworn to by him on the 29th day of September A.D.1953.

AND WHEREAS the said Peter.K.Loewen has offered to sell his aforesaid portion of land to the said Municipality at and for the sum of One Hundred and Ten (\$110.00) Dollars and the said Peter.B.Dueck has offered to sell his aforesaid portion of land to the said Municipality at and for the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars.


AND WHEREAS the aforesaid offers are deemed to be fair and reasonable.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted and it is hereby enacted in Council duly assembled, that the Rural Municipality of Morris purchase the aforesaid properties from the parties aforesaid at and for the sums hereinbefore mentioned, pursuant to Section 393.s.s.(e) of the Municipal Act, being Cap 141 R.S.M. and amendments thereto and that the necessary documents be prepared and executed.
