

BY-LAW NO. 798


Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris for constructing, opening and making a road over and across the South West Quarter of Section Thirteen (13) in Township Six (6) and Range Two (2) East of the Principal Meridian in the Province of Manitoba.


WHEREAS it is necessary and advisable to construct, open and make a road over and across the South West Quarter of Section Thirteen (13) in Township Six (6) and Range Two (2) East of the Principal Meridian in the Province of Manitoba, and it is deemed necessary to enter upon, break up, acquire, take and use certain lands necessary and desirable for such purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris in session duly assembled enacts as follows-

1. That the road be constructed, opened and made across the ~~South~~ West Quarter of Section ~~Thirteen~~(13) in Township Six (6) and Range Two (2) East of the Principal Meridian in the Province of Manitoba, in accordance with a Plan of Survey made by Charles Dudley Brown, Manitoba Land Surveyor and sworn to on the 29th day of September A.D.1953.
2. That the lands shewn colored Pink on said Plan be entered upon, broken up, acquired and taken for such purpose.
3. That the Officers of the said Municipality be and they are hereby authorized to take all necessary steps.
 - (a) to obtain Title to the lands colored Pink as shewn on said Plan, either by obtaining a conveyance from the owner of said lands, or by expropriating said lands under the provisions of The Expropriation Act, and
 - (b) to pay to the owner of said lands such compensation as may be agreed upon between the Council and the said owner or such amount as may be fixed by arbitration under the Expropriation Act and The Arbitration Act.
