

BY-LAW NO. 799A

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris to open establish and maintain a dyke or drain and acquire a right of way for such purposes over land within the jurisdiction of the Municipal Corporation.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Municipal Act being Cap 141 of the Revised Statutes of Manitoba, 1940, every Municipal Corporation may pass by-laws for the opening, establishing and maintaining dykes or drains and for acquiring of right-of-way over the property upon which said dykes or drains are situate.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris desires to open, establish and maintain a dyke or drain within its jurisdiction over and upon certain portions of Sections Thirty-one (31) and Thirty-two (32) in Township Four (4) and Range Two (2) West of the Principal Meridian in the Province of Manitoba.

AND WHEREAS the land required to be taken for the aforesaid purpose has been acquired by the Municipal Corporation by the previous owners thereof.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris in meeting duly assembled enacts as follows-

1. That a drain or dyke be opened, established and maintained over and upon those portions of Sections Thirty-one (31) and Thirty-two (32) in Township Four (4) and Range Two (2) West of the Principal Meridian in the Province of Manitoba, as shown colored pink for dyke or drain and as shown colored brown for floodway on a map or plan of survey of said parcels of land made or superintended by Charles Dudley Brown, M.L.S. and sworn to on the 22nd day of June A.D. 1950 and approved by Mr. W.S. Young, Examiner of Surveys on the 12th day of July A.D. 1950.
2. That following the passage of this by-law, the officials, servants and agents of the Municipality are authorized to enter upon said lands and to mark, survey, construct and maintain said dyke or drain and take all proceedings necessary to make such dyke or drain available for use.
3. That the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer of said Municipality be and are hereby authorized, instructed and empowered for and on behalf of the said Municipality to ~~execute~~ execute any documents necessary to register said plan, transfers and floodway agreements, relative and concerning the aforesaid dyke or drain and floodway, and to register same in the proper Land Titles Office and to pay all proper costs in order to obtain Title in the name of the said Municipality.
