

BY-LAW NO. 804

BEING a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the acquiring of land within its confines for a public cemetery, and for laying out, improving and managing the same.

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Morris is desirous of acquiring land for the above purposes.

AND WHEREAS BERTUS REMMER OLTMAN, of the Post Office of Lowe Farm in Manitoba, Farmer is the registered owner of the following land, to wit, The most Easterly Three Hundred and Nine (309) feet in width of the North East Quarter of Section 31-4-1 West of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, lying between the Southern limit of the Right-of-Way of the Northern Pacific and Manitoba Railway as shown on a Plan thereof filed in the Morden Land Titles Office as No. 297, and a line drawn South of parallel with and perpendicularly distant Three Hundred and Nine (309) feet from the said Southern limit excepting thereout the most Easterly Two Hundred and Nine (209) feet in width of the most Northerly Two Hundred and Nine (209) feet in depth of the land herein described, and is willing to Transfer the aforesaid property to the said Municipality at and for the price and sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted and it is hereby enacted pursuant to Section 419 of the Municipal Act, being Cap 141.R.S.M.1940 and amendments thereto, that this Council purchase the aforesaid land at and for the sum and price of One (\$1.00) Dollar and that the necessary documents be prepared relative to the Transfer thereof.
