BY-LAW No. 811
of The Rural Municipality of Morris, respecting the
School District of Lowe Farm, No. 1033

WHEREAS By-Law No. 1-55 of the School District of Lowe Farm, No. 1033 has been passed and approved by the Municipal and Public Utility Board for the purpose of borrowing the sum of Sixty five thousand dollars (\$65,000.00) on the credit of the said School District for the purpose of erecting a 4-room school with science room, commercial room, general shops and an auditorium convertible to two classrooms at a total cost of \$80,000.

NOW THEREFORE it is deemed expedient to fix the day and hour and the place or places where votes are to be taken and the naming of a Deputy Returning Officer, and a time and place when the Clerk is to sum up the number of votes for and against the said proposed By-Law and a time and place for the appointment of persons to represent those interested respectively in promoting or opposing the passage of the proposed By-Law to attend at the polling places and at the final summing up of the votes by the Clerk.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted and it is hereby enacted that the time and place for taking the votes of the duly qualified electors of the said School District for and against the said By-Law No. 1-55 is TUESDAY APRIL 12th, A.D. 1955, between the hours of 9:00 o'clock in the forenoon and 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon(Standard Time) and the polling place shall be at the FIRE HALL in the Village of Lowe Farm, in the Province of Manitoba.

AND FURTHER that the Reeve of The Rural Municipality of Morris, shall at the Office of the Clerk in the Town of Morris in Manitoba, on Saturday April 9th, A.D. 1955, at the hour of 11:00 o'clock in the forenoon(if requested so to do) appoint persons to attend at the polling place and at the final summing up of the votes by the Clerk on behalf of the persons interested in the said By-Law to promote or oppose the passage of same.

AND FURTHER that Norman Spalding, Lowe Farm, Manitoba, is hereby appointed Deputy Returning Officer to take the votes at the Poll hereinbefore referred to.

AND FURTHER that the Clerk of the Rural Municipality of Morris will attend at his office at the Town of Morris in the Province of Manitoba on Wednesday April the 13th A.D. 1955 at the hour of 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon and will sum up the votes for and against the said By-Law.

AND FURTHER that a copy of said By-Law No. 1-55 be placed on file in the office of the Clerk of the Rural Municipality of Morris in the Province of Manitoba and that same may be inspected by all interested parties at all reasonable hours before the vote thereon is taken.
