BY-LAW No. 814

A By-Law of The Rural Municipality of Morris for submitting By-Law No. 810 to the electors, re: "Establishing further Hospital facilities for the Carman Hospital District No. 20, by authorising the construction of a Medical Nursing Unit at St. Claude, Manitoba".

WHEREAS By-Law No. 810 of The Rural Municipality of Morris has been approved by the Municipal and Public Utility Board under Board Order No. 112/55 for the purpose of "Establishing further Hospital facilities for the Carman Hospital District No. 20",

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris in session assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The said By-Law No. 810 shall be submitted to the electors qualified to vote thereon, on Friday June 10th, A.D. 1955; the Poll shall be open between the hours of 9 o'clock in the forenoon and 5 o'clock in the afternoon of the said date, at the following place: The MASONIC HALL, in the Village of Sperling, Manitoba.
2. The Deputy Returning Officer for taking of the said votes shall be, W.H. Hamilton of the Village of Sperling, Man.
3. On the 9th day of June A.D. 1955 at the hour of 11:00 a.m. the Reeve of The Rural Municipality of Morris, shall attend at the Municipal Office (if requested so to do), for the purpose of appointing persons to attend at the Polling place and at the final summing up of the votes by the Clerk on behalf of persons interested in the said By-Law, to promote or oppose the passage of same.
4. THAT a copy of said By-Law No. 810 be placed on file in the office of the Clerk of The Rural Municipality of Morris in the Province of Manitoba, and that same may be inspected by all interested parties at all reasonable hours before the vote thereon is taken.
5. THAT the Clerk of The Rural Municipality of Morris, of Morris, Manitoba, will attend at his office in the Town of Morris on Saturday, June 11th, A.D. 1955, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon and will sum up the votes FOR and AGAINST the said By-Law.
