

BY-LAW NO. 827

BEING a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the opening of a Public Road and the closing and opening of a Public Drain and the establishment and maintenance thereof, within the confines of said Municipality, over and upon the following lands, to wit, Sections Twelve and One in Township Four and Range One West of the Principal Meridian in the Province of Manitoba, and Sections Seven, Seventeen, and Eighteen in Township Four and Range One East of the Principal Meridian in said Province.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Municipal Act, being Cap 173 R.S.M. and amendments thereto, every Municipal Corporation may pass by-laws for the closing and opening of roads and drains within its confines.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to open establish and maintain a Public Road and close and open a Public Drain over and upon the aforesaid lands.

AND WHEREAS a price for compensation has been agreed upon between the owners of the lands so affected, with the said Municipality, at the rate of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars per acre for any lands so taken, for the aforesaid purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Morris in session duly assembled enacts as follows-

1. THAT all that portion of Section Twelve (12) in Township Four (4) and Range One (1) West of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, taken for a Public Drain as same is shewn colored Pink on a Plan of same registered in the Morden Land Titles Office as No.304 and that portion of Section One (1) in Township Four (4) and Range One (1) West of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba taken for a Public Drain as same is shewn colored Pink on a Plan of same registered in said Land Titles Office as No.284 which lies within the limits of land required for a Public Road as same is shewn colored Pink on a Plan of Survey made by Mr.T.Ralph Miller, M.L.S. and sworn to by him on the 3rd day of October A.D.1952, be and is hereby closed.

2. THAT all those portions of Sections One (1) and Twelve (12) in Township Four (4) and Range One (1) West of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, required for a Public Road and a Public Drain, as same are shewn colored Pink and Green respectively, on a Plan of Survey made by the said T.Ralph Miller, M.L.S. and sworn to by him on the 3rd day of October A.D.1952 be and are hereby opened.



2. THAT all that portion of Section Seven (7) in Township Four (4) and Range One (1) East of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, taken for a Public Drain as same is shewn colored Pink on a Plan of same registered in the Winnipeg Land Titles Office as No.3257 which lies within the limits of land required for a Public Road as same is shewn colored Pink on a Plan of Survey made by T.Ralph Miller, M.L.S, and sworn to by him on the 3rd day of October A.D.1952 be and is hereby closed.

THAT all those portions of Sections Seven (7) Seventeen (17) and Eighteen (18) in Township Four (4) Range One (1) East of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba required for the purposes of a Public Road and that portion of said Section Seven (7) required for a Public Drain as same are shewn colored Pink and Green respectively on a Plan of Survey made by the said T.Ralph Miller, M.L.S and sworn to ^{by} him on the 3rd day of October A.D.1952, be and are hereby opened.

3. AND that the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer of this Municipality be and are hereby authorized, instructed and empowered, on behalf of the Municipality to execute all necessary documents relative thereto, for the transference or otherwise and for the acquisition of all those portions of land to be taken for a new Road to be opened, in the name of Her Majesty the Queen in Right of the Province of Manitoba, and for the acquisition of all those portions taken for a Drain in the name of the said Municipality.
