

BEING A BY-LAW of the Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the sale of the following property, to wit;

" All that portion of the South West Quarter of Section Twenty-nine, in Township Six and Range Two, West of the Principal Meridian in the Province of Manitoba, described as follows-Commencing at a point on the South side of Station Street, in the Village of Sperling, where the said South side of Station Street is intersected by the West side of the lane running Northward along the West side of Block Three, as said Station Street, land and block, are shewn on a Plan of Survey of said Village of Sperling, registered in the Carman Land Titles Office as No. 916, Thence Westerly along the said South side of Station Street Forty feet, Thence Southerly parallel to the said lane One Hundred feet, Thence Easterly parallel to said Station Street Forty feet to the Western limit of said land to the point of commencement."

AND WHEREAS the said Municipality is the registered owner of the aforesaid lane.

AND WHEREAS the said Municipality has received an offer from the Manitoba Telephone System in the amount of \$200.00 for said property, title to issue in the name of Her Majesty the Queen in Right of the Province of Manitoba, and said offer is deemed to be a fair and reasonable one.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted and it is hereby enacted that the said Municipality of Morris do now sell the aforesaid land to the aforesaid purchaser at and for the aforesaid price and that the proper officers of the Municipality execute all necessary documents relative thereto.
