

BY-LAW No. 832

A By-Law of The Rural Municipality of Morris appointing polling places and setting the time for polls to remain open in the 1956 elections.

.....

WHEREAS it is necessary to appoint polling places and set the time for polls to remain open in the election of a Councillor for Ward Four, for the years 1957 and 1958, according to Sec's. 122(2) and 123 of The Municipal Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris in special session assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT the following shall be the polling places in Ward Four:

POLL No. ONE:- ARMOUR SCHOOL for all duly qualified electors of said Ward living South of the division line between Townships 5 & 6.

POLL No. TWO:- Residence of THEODORE ~~CHERRY~~<sup>MARCOUX</sup> in the Village of AUBIGNY, for all duly qualified electors of said Ward living North of the division line between Townships 5 and 6.

AND

THAT the polls remain open from ten o'clock in the forenoon until nine o'clock in the afternoon on Friday, October 19th, 1956.
