

BEING a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Morris relative to the taking of a referendum under The Liquor Control Act.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient pursuant to the aforesaid Act to pass a by-law to approve the issue of certain licences in respect of premises situate in the said Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to Section 259 (2) of The Liquor Control Act being Cap 40 R.S.M. 1956, be it enacted and it is hereby enacted as follows-

1. THAT this By-Law be submitted to the electors of the said Municipality, entitled to vote thereon, for the approval of the issuance of the following classes of licences for the sale of liquor, in respect of premises situate in said Municipality, namely;

Restaurant, Beer and Wine Licence.

Beverage Room Licence.

Dining Room Liquor Licence.

Cocktail Room Licence.

Cabaret Licence.

2. That voting on said By-Law will take place on Thursday the 9th day of May A.D. 1957 between the hours of 9.00 o'clock in the forenoon and 5.00 o'clock in the afternoon, Standard Time, at the following places-

Poll 1. Broadview School. N.W. 16-4-1.E.

Poll 2. Residence of L. Taylor. N.E. 24-5-1.E.

Poll 3. Residence of P.T. Wiens. Village of McTavish Man.

Poll 4. Residence of Theodore Marcoux, Village of Aubigny Man.

Poll 5. The Fire Hall at the Village of Lowe Farm Man.

Poll 6. The Masonic Hall at the Village of Sperling Man.

3. That on Wednesday the 1st day of May A.D. 1957 at the hour of 10.00 o'clock in the forenoon the Reeve of the Rural Municipality of Morris shall attend at the office of the Secretary-Treasurer of the said Municipality at the Town of Morris in Manitoba, for the purpose of, if requested so to do, for the appointment of persons on behalf of those interested in and desirous of promoting or opposing the passage of the said By-Law, to attend at the various polling places, and for the appointment of persons to attend the

the official summing up of the votes by the Clerk of the Municipality

4. That the Clerk of the Municipality shall attend at his office at the Town of Morris in Manitoba on Friday the 10th day of May A.D.1957 at the hour of 9.00 o'clock in the forenoon and will sum up the votes for and against said By-Law.

5. That David J.Harder of the ~~Town~~ of Morris in Manitoba, be and is hereby appointed as Returning Officer relative to the aforesaid referendum.

6. That a copy of this By-Law be placed on file in the office of the Secretary-Treasurer of the Municipality and may be examined at all reasonable times prior to the taking of the vote.
