

BY-LAW No. 847r

A By-Law of The Rural Municipality of Morris appointing Polling Places and setting the time for polls to remain open in the election of a Reeve.

WHEREAS it is necessary to appoint polling places and set the time for polls to remain open in the election of a Reeve for the years 1958 and 1959, according to Sec's. 122(2) and 123 of The Municipal Act:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Rural Municipality of Morris in session assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT the following shall be the Polling Places for this election:

Ward 1:- Poll 1- BROADVIEW SCHOOL, for all duly qualified electors of Ward 1.

Ward 2:- Poll 1- HEABERT SCHOOL- for all duly qualified electors of Ward two residing WEST of MERIDIAN.
Poll 2 - L.TAYLOR residence- for all duly qualified electors of Ward Two residing EAST of MERIDIAN.

Ward 3:- Poll 1- LEA BANK SCHOOL- for all duly qualified electors of Ward Three residing WEST of C.P.R.
Poll 2 - PELLAND'S STORE, Silver Plains- for all duly qualified electors of Ward Three residing EAST of C.P.R.

Ward 4:- Poll 1- ARMOUR SCHOOL- for all duly qualified electors of Ward Four residing SOUTH of Division Line between Townships 5 and 6 (South of R.L.418 and sections 35 and 36 - 6 - 2 E)
Poll 2- THEO MARCOUX residence, Aubigny- for all duly qualified electors of Ward Four residing North of Division Line between Townships 5 & 6 (North of RL 416 & Sec's 25/26-5-2E)

Ward 5:- LOWE FARM FIRE HALL, for all qualified electors of Ward Five residing 3 miles West and 2 miles East of Lowe Farm.
Poll 2- J.J.Toew's Garage, Kane- for all duly qualified electors of Ward Five residing 3 miles East of Kane.

Ward 6:- Poll 1-ORANCE HALL, Sperling: for all duly qualified electors of Ward Six residing North of Township 6.
Poll 2- NEUFELD SCHOOL- for all duly qualified electors of Ward Six residing SOUTH of Township 6.

AND THAT the polls remain open from nine o'clock in the forenoon until six o'clock in the afternoon on Friday, October 18th, A.D. 1957 .
