

BY-LAW No. 860<sup>^</sup>  
of the Rural Municipality of Morris

authorizing the sale of part of Lot 50 Block D  
Plan 916, Sperling.

WHEREAS Marcel Rose of the Village of Sperling,  
Province of Manitoba, farmer has offered to purchase for the  
sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) the following property:

"In the Village of Sperling, in the Province  
of Manitoba, and being the most Westerly fifty  
feet in width of the most northerly one hundred  
and fifty feet in depth of Block "D", which block  
is shewn on a plan of survey of said Village,  
registered in the Carman Land Titles Office  
(Winnipeg Division), as No. 916," subject to  
Special Reservations as to Mines, Minerals and  
other matters as particularly defined in Cap 52  
S. M. 1949.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted as By-law No. 860  
of the Rural Municipality of Morris that the said offer of  
Marcel Rose be and is hereby accepted and that the Reeve  
and Secretary Treasurer be authorized to sign the necessary  
transfer.
